Florida JCI Senate | Constitution & By-Laws Committee

Please consider for vote at the May Membership meeting the proposed summary of changes to the current FL JCI Senate, Inc. By-Laws.

Modification:

Article VII Committees

Section 7.2 Finance Committee

Under part d), delete the sentences:

“The term of office for (a) shall be one year. The term of office for (c) shall be two years and may be reappointed successively one time.”

Replace with the following change for definition and clarification purposes:

Section 7.2(A) Term Limits

1. Term limits for 3 members at large shall be 2 years and may be reappointed successively one time.
2. Treasurer and Legal Counsel shall serve a one-year term as referenced under Article IV Section 4.3 Term of Officers.
3. Financial Compliance Officer shall serve a term of two years with no term limits as defined in Article VI Section 6.12 as an appointee by the President.

Amend Article XIII Bylaws and Policy Section 13.1

CHANGE NOTIFICATION of amendments and bylaws from “at least two (2) weeks prior to the date of voting” to “at least one (1) month prior to the date of voting.”
